Terms & conditions :

1.	The sealed quotations should be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) either in cash or Demand Draft drawn in favour of Officer in charge, NBPGR, Thrissur and should be submitted to the undersigned on or before 2.00 PM on 25/05/2018. The quotations will be opened at 3.00 PM on 25/05/2018. Late quotations or quotations without EMD will summarily be rejected.
2.	The Officer in charge reserves the right to harvest 20 fruits each from 30 marked Malabar Tamarind trees, which the successful bidder has to retain in the tree till ripening as we need the same for research work.
3.	The successful bidder has to pay the entire amount within 3 days after approval, before harvesting the fruits and taking possession of the articles.
4.	The successful bidder has to harvest and remove the auctioned article at this/her own cost and risk during office hours on working days only, and get a gate-pass issued by the authorised officer, which has to be signed and surrendered in original to the security guard before taking the articles outside the campus, each time. However, the harvest process should not damage any of the trees or fence or other crops in the farm or hamper the routine activities of the station in any manner.
5.	If the successful bidder, whose bidding is accepted, refuses to pay the balance amount in full as per the bid amount within 3 days after approval, he/she will have to forfeit the EMD and the right over the auctioned article.
6.	This office will not take any responsibility for the safe custody of the material sold through bid/auction to the bidder.
7.	Interested parties can visit the station / farm to have a first-hand assessment before submitting their quotation on any working day between 10.00 AM and 4.00 PM under prior intimation.
8.	Last day for harvesting the fruits by the successful bidder will be 30/09/2018.
9.	Taxes / levies, if any as per rules shall be payable by the successful bidder.
10.	The Officer in charge reserves the right to reject or accept any bid, even the highest without assigning any reason thereto and to modify any of the above conditions. The decision of the Officer in charge will be final in all matters.
