Terms and conditions

- Upper age limit: JRF- 35 years on the date of advertisement. Age limits are relaxable for SC, ST and OBC candidates as per Govt. of India norms. Age limit for women candidates is relaxed by 5 years for above post. Preference will be given to candidates having evidence of experience in the relevant area and NET/GATE qualification.
- Emoluments – For JRF/SRF salary is as per revised DST OM SR/S9/Z-09/2012. Candidates without NET/GATE and with a post graduation degree in basic sciences shall receive lower emoluments as indicated above.
- The candidates are requested to send their well-typed biodata in advance before the interview by post or email to Dr Anuradha Agrawal (PI), Tissue Culture and Cryopreservation Unit, ICAR-NBPGR, New Delhi-110012 (email: anuradha.agrawal@icar.gov.in). Biodata should be typed on plain paper, stating the name, address, date of birth, educational qualifications, experience, etc. Additional information can be enquired through the same e-mail.

4. Candidates should bring biodata along with original marks sheets, certificates, photograph and other testimonials for verification and submit a self-attested copy of the same along with the application form. Mention clearly on top of the form the post and name of project applied for.
5. The post is purely temporary and co-terminus with the tenure of the project. The appointment does not confer any entitlement or right over the job and will not be considered as formal service. The selected candidates will be required to give an undertaking to continue to work for at least 1 year, however, the progress of selected candidates will be reviewed by the PI after every 6 months to allow him/her to continue further.
