

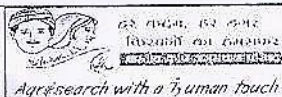

### Terms and Conditions:

- The posts are purely temporary and co-terminus with the project which is upto 31/03/2020. Selected candidates will have no right to claim for regularization or absorption whatsoever in the NBPGR/ICAR.
- Age limit:** The minimum and upper age limit for Young Professional-II will be as under:  
Minimum age: 21 years and the maximum age 45 years with the maximum age relaxation of SC/ST candidates and OBC candidates will be provided as per ICAR/G.O.I. norms and regulations.
- The appointment shall be for one year (12 months) if the performance of the young professional-II is satisfactory or may be terminated earlier if the performance is NOT satisfactory. If the work of the YP-II is satisfactory then his/her tenure will be extended to next six months/till the project duration, whichever is the earliest.
- NO TA/DA will be admissible for attending the interview.
- Candidates must produce all the original certificates at the time of interview along with brief bio-data, recent passport size photograph and a set of self attested photocopies of all documents.
- The date of Interview is on 31/10/2018. The candidates should reach ICAR-NBPGR, New Building, Pusa Campus, New Delhi-110012 by 10:30 AM on the date of interview.
