1. Calculation procedure of APARs for last five years:-

The APARs of last five years will be considered/taken into account for the candidates who qualify the written part of the exam. The marks allotted for APARs of last five years are 100 (20 for each year APAR) and calculation of marks of APARs will be done as follows:-

- 1. APARs graded between 8 and 10 will be given a score of 9 for the purpose of calculation of score for empanelment/promotion and (9x2) =18 marks will be added with the written marks.
- 2. APARs graded between 6 and short of 8 will be given a score of 7 and (7x2) = 14 marks will be added with the written marks.
- 3. APARs graded between 4 and short of 6 will be given a score of 5 and (5x) = 10 marks will be added with the written marks.
- 4. APARs graded below 4 will be given a score of "Zero".

Merit of the candidates shall be arrived by calculating total marks obtained, <u>out of maximum marks of 400 (i.e 300 for written +100 APAR).</u>

- Note-1: Candidates are allowed the option to answer the Paper-II on Noting, Drafting and Office Procedure either in English or Hindi.
- Note-2: The option will be for a complete paper and not for different question in the same paper
- Note-3: Candidates desirous of exercising the option to answer the aforesaid paper in Hindi (Devanagri) or in English should indicate clearly in the application form, otherwise, it would be presumed that they would answer the Paper in English.
- Note-4: The option exercised shall be final and no request for alteration in the application form shall ordinarily be entertained.
- Note-5: Question paper in respect of Paper-I(a) and Paper-II will be supplied both in English and Hindi.
- Note-6: No credit for Paper-II will be given for an answer written in a language other than the one opted by the candidate.

Deduction up to 5 percent of the maximum marks in the written subject will be made for illegible handwriting.

Syllabus of Examination PART-A

Standard & Syllabus of the Written Test.

Paper-I

(a) General Awareness:-

Question will be aimed at testing the candidates General Awareness of the environment around him and its application to society, Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of every day observations and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of any educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to History, Culture, Geography, Economics, Science, General Politic and Scientific research.

(b) Comprehension and Writing Ability of English Language:

Questions will be designed to test the candidates understanding and knowledge of English language, Vocabulary, spelling, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms, sentence completion, phrases and idiomatic use of words etc. There will be question on comprehension of a passage also.

Paper-II

(a) Noting Drafting and Office Procedure:

The paper on Noting, Drafting and Office Procedure will be designed to test the candidates knowledge of office procedure in the Secretariat and Attached Offices and, in general, their ability to write and understand notes and drafts, Rules and Bye Laws of ICAR, Audit Manual and Delegation of Powers.
