


Additional Notes:

- i) Processing fee would be chargeable for the rejected samples also as per their category/ plant type.
- ii) In the event of grant of relaxation by the Competent Authority (in respect of Phytosanitary Certificate and/ or Clause 9(2), the consignment will be released to the indentor after levying **five times the normal fee** [Plant Quarantine (Regulation of Import into India) Order, 2003 Chapter VI Clause 14(2)].
- iii) In the event of the indenter not taking material after quarantine processing due to their own justified reasons and request for incineration by ICAR-NBPGR, five times the normal processing fee would be levied. In case they do not pay the required penalty, the indenting firm/ organization would not be allowed for further import till the existing dues are cleared.
